Pallet Wall Garden

Perfect for small spaces! Staple landscape fabric to the bottom, back, and sides of your pallet, leaving spaces between the slats, leaving spaces between the slats and the top uncovered. Lay the pallet on the ground, fill the openings with plants and potting soil. Leave on the ground for a couple of weeks, watering as needed, to allow roots to grow.



Chandelier Container

Shop local thrift stores or yard sales to find a chandelier. Remove electrical components with wire cutters. Attach pots and saucers with hot glue, then spray paint the entire chandelier and allow to dry completely. Fill pots with potting soil and your favorite plants, then hang using an "S" hook. Water and feed plants as needed.



Creative Reuses

Use a pin to poke a hole in the bottom of an empty eggshell half, then place it in an egg carton and fill with soil and seeds. Once your seedling appears, plant the egg in the ground.

Wrap a worn hose into a wreath shape and secure with zip ties. Decorate with ribbon, flowers and gardening tools.

Many things can be repurposed as a planter simply by adding soil. Buckets, colanders, old boots, coffee mugs... even the kitchen sink!
